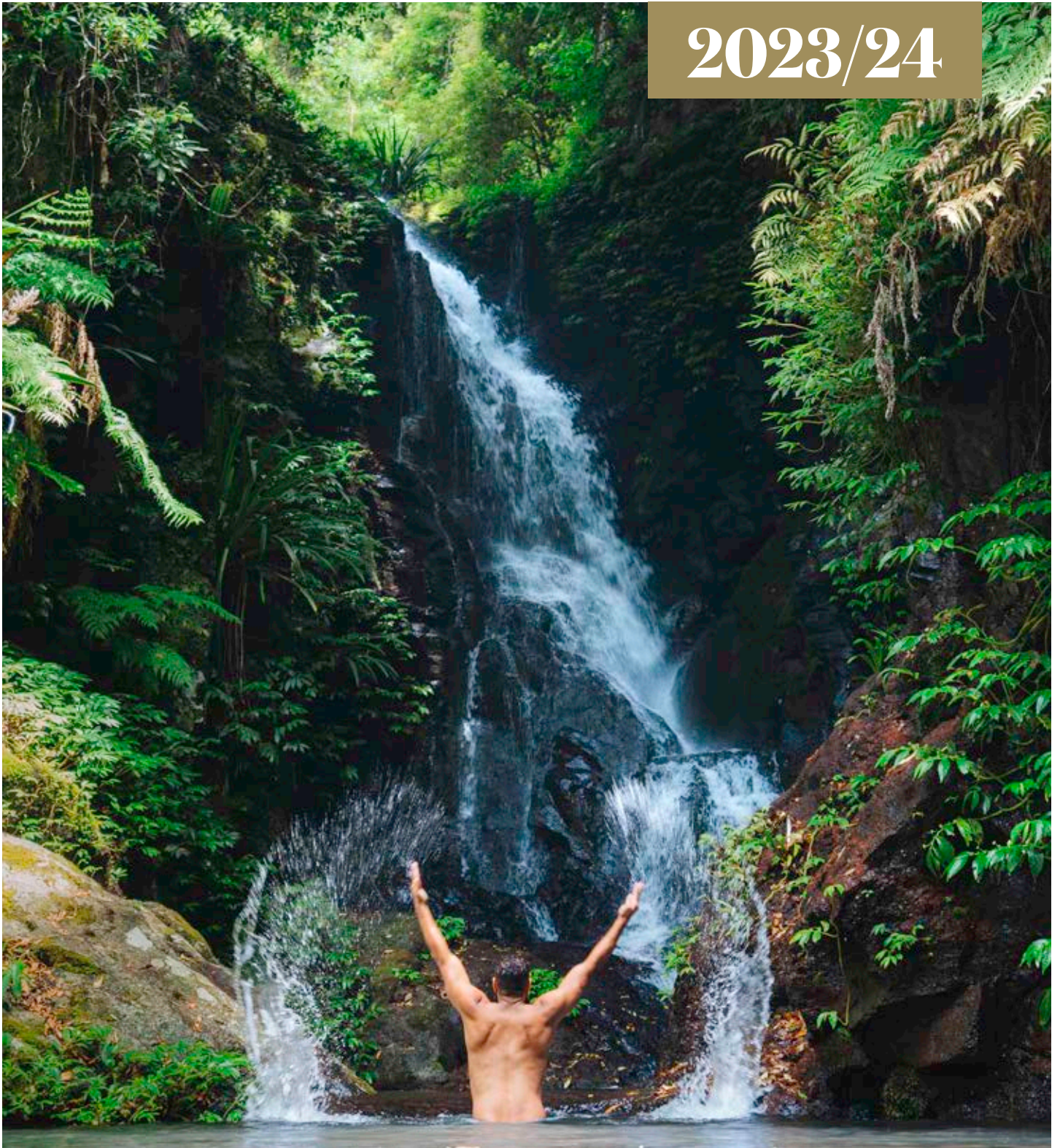

Framed by impressive volcanic mountains dating back millions of years, this vast region traverses epic peaks and valleys, verdant rainforests and fertile farmland.

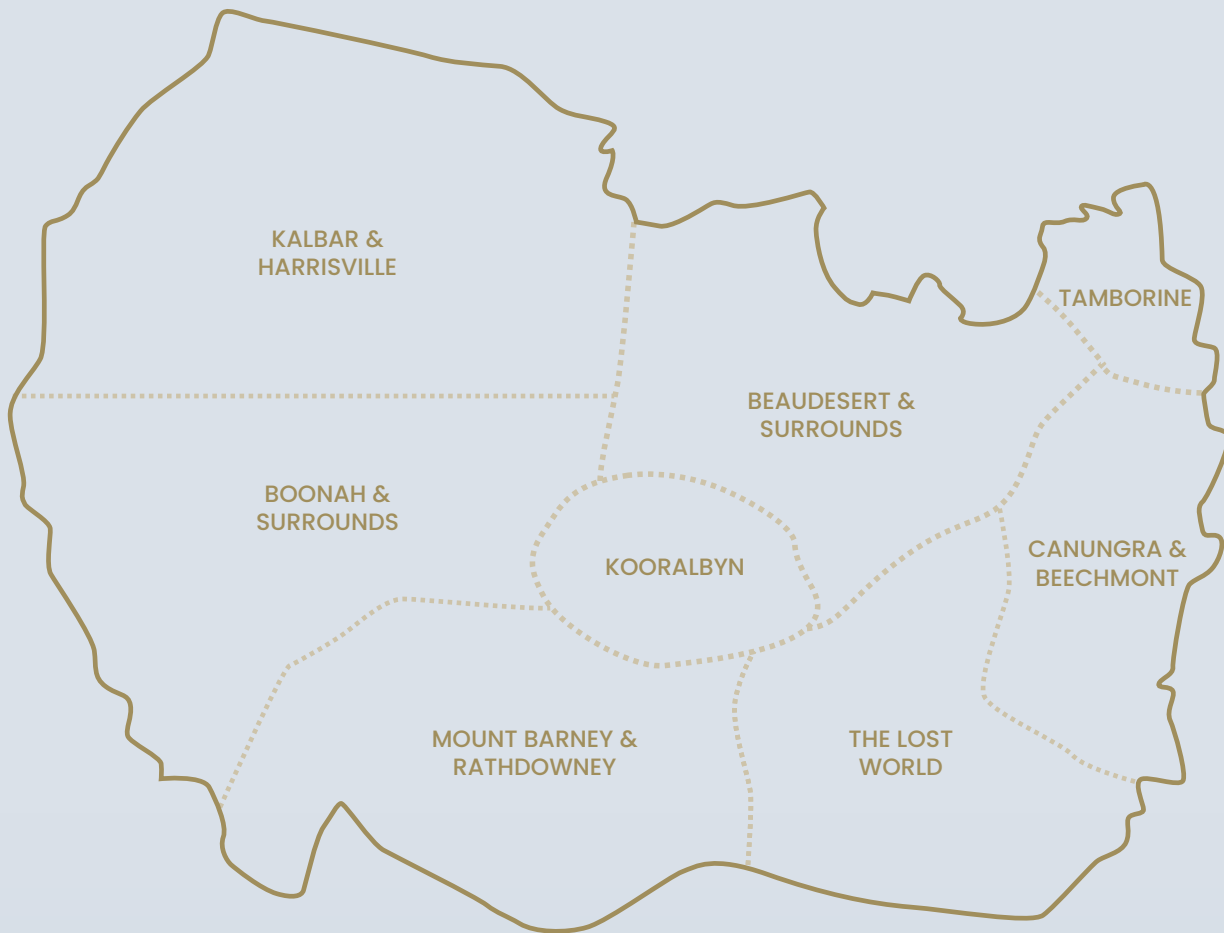

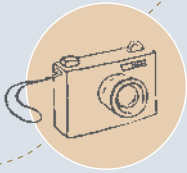


Scenic Rim region

The Scenic Rim is less than 60 minutes drive south west of Brisbane, and a similar time west of the Gold Coast. The region itself is an expanse of more than 4,000 square kilometres, three times the size of Brisbane.

ORIGIN

The Scenic Rim was named by adventurer, naturalist and tourism pioneer, Arthur Groom in the mid 1900s. He was describing the chain of mountains around the valleys between Brisbane and Tamborine Mountain and then it was known as the Scenic Rim.

INDIGENOUS MEANING

The original inhabitants of the Scenic Rim area were the Mununjali, Yugambah and Ugarapul Aboriginal people.

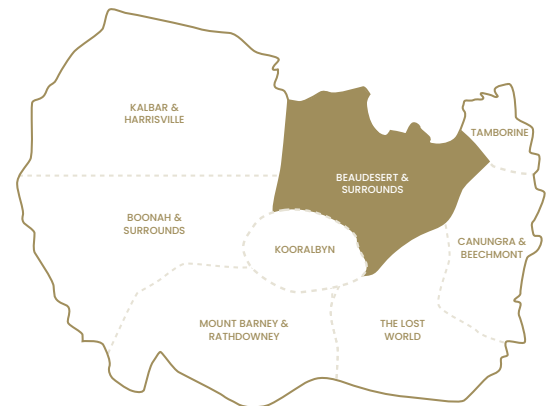

BEAUDESERT & SURROUNDS

Sky-high views, honey sweet farm stops, handmade deliciousness and buildings with stories that are hundreds of years old. Whether behind the wheel, armed with a paddle or a knife and fork in hand, there are plenty of ways to make the most of every gem.



Beaudesert is the gateway to the region's natural attractions. its vibrant commercial centre is the perfect location to kickstart your Scenic Rim experience.

Building on its agricultural roots, the town is a farming and equine hub with a bustling CBD that hosts an art gallery, museum and cultural centre. Kooralbyn is an easy 25-minute drive from Beaudesert – a hinterland paradise tucked into a secluded

valley with a tranquil village for a relaxing getaway.

Food is front and centre with charming country pubs, cafes as well as The Overflow Estate 1895 winery and restaurant set in a stunning location. Visit Towri Sheep Cheeses to learn the art of cheesemaking, browse Beaudesert and Kooralbyn markets for fresh food or take a stroll down the main street to treat yourself to coffee.

The area is also a launchpad for outdoor activities and wildlife spotting with its close proximity to Mt Barney and Mt Maroon, Lake Wyaralong and a great range of 4WD and mountain biking trails. If a spot of golf takes your fancy, there's an expansive golf course only a stone's throw from the town centre.

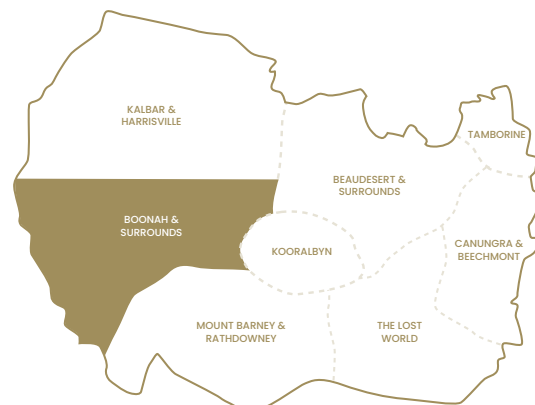

A vibrant town with rural roots, Boonah is located in the Scenic Rim's west around 1.5 hour's drive from Brisbane and the Gold Coast. With Moogerah Peaks, Main Range National Parks, Lake Moogerah and Maroon on its doorstep, Boonah is the ideal launchpad for outdoor adventure.

Most roads lead to the water where you can dive into swimming, fishing, stand-up paddleboarding and

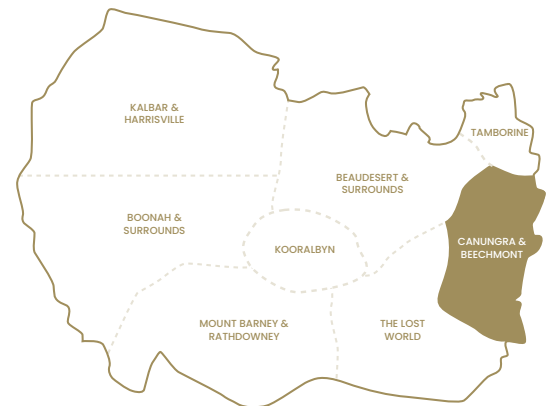

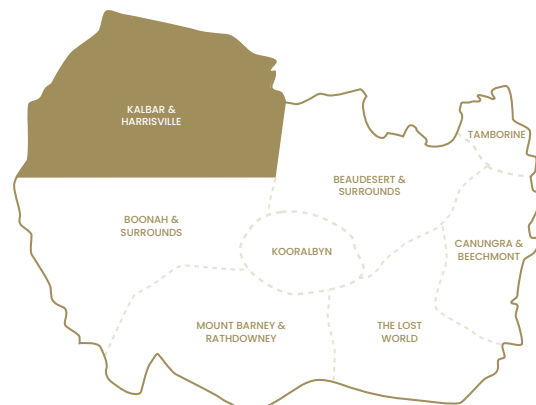

The Scenic Rim's northern hub of Kalbar, Harrisville, Peak Crossing and Roadvale is sure to satisfy your cravings for fresh fare and country

Settled by German immigrant farmers in the 1870s, Kalbar's pioneering heritage can be seen in historic buildings and welcoming cafes, pubs, providores and bakeries that offer hearty homestyle food with locally grown produce. Smaller historic towns nearby include Roadvale, Harrisville

and Peak Crossing, each with its own pub and main street.

Summer Land Camels near Harrisville is a must-visit to see the resident camels and wander the charming homestead, shop and farm. For specialty gifts, local produce and handmade collectibles, Kalbar's main business area is brimming with character, including Postmaster's Sweets, located in the Post Office, and the Scenic Rim Farm Shop & Café.

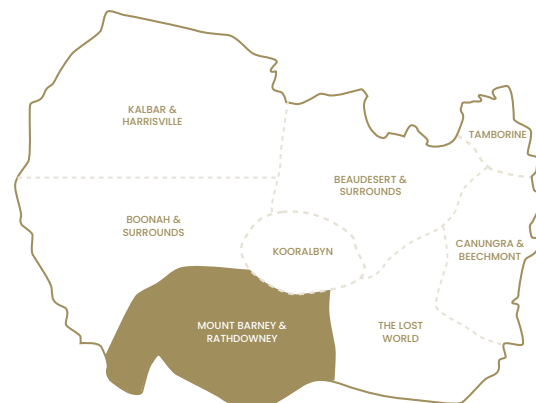

MOUNT BARNEY & RATHDOWNNEY

Experience rugged mountains and epic heights one moment, then the genuine warmth of smiles down the main street of country villages that exude charm. There's action for those who want thrills and peace for those who need to stop.



Rathdowney is in the Scenic Rim's south, just 32km from Beaudesert and provides access to the many impressive walking and climbing tracks in nearby Mount Barney National Park.

The tiny township occupies lush pastoral land and vast open spaces at the base of two majestic mountains, hosting monthly markets and food options such as the historic Rathdowney Hotel, cafés and restaurants.

The World Heritage-listed Mount Barney National Park is surrounded by valleys, caves, rockpools and woodland forest, primed for outdoor adventure and nature experiences. The designated wilderness park is marked by seven mountains, including Mt Barney, Queensland's fourth-highest peak that offers some of the Scenic Rim's most challenging walks and pristine bushland teeming with wildlife.

There are plenty of family-friendly accommodation options available from camping to glamping, farm stays and lodge cabins, allowing you to stay and explore this outdoors hub at your leisure.

TAMBORINE

Welcome to a land of lush green mountains that will have you longing to get your head lost in the clouds. Just a one-hour drive from Brisbane or 45 minutes from the Gold Coast, Tamborine Mountain is lovingly referred to as the green behind the gold.



Tucked into the hinterland just 20 minutes' drive from the Gold Coast, Tamborine Mountain is truly a hidden gem, surrounded by boutique wineries, historic pubs, quirky gift shops, art galleries and natural wonders.

The village feel envelops you like a warm hug. The main hub hosts a strip of characterful shops, restaurants, cafes, wineries and art galleries, making it easy to visit multiple sites on your trip. Stop



at one of the many cellar doors, call into Tamborine Mountain Distillery for liqueur tasting or take a crop-to-cup tour at Tamborine Mountain Coffee Plantation.

The meandering country roads are a pleasure to motor along, stopping at elevated lookouts with breathtaking views from the vantage point of 550m above sea level.

For sensory respite in serene surrounds, head to Tamborine



National Park, wander the tropical-meets-temperate plant displays at the Tamborine Mountain Regional Botanic Gardens or experience family-friendly adventures at Thunderbird Park. For adventurers who love a view, get a top-down vista from the lush rainforest canopy at the Tamborine Rainforest Skywalk and TreeTop Challenge or simply stay a little longer at the stylish Cedar Creek Lodges.

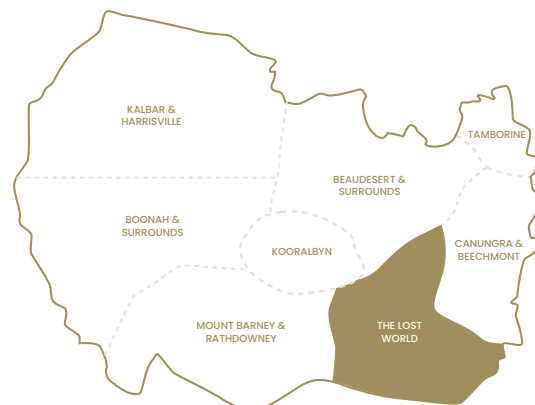

THE LOST WORLD

The Lost World is a hidden plateau, a green shelf on Razorback Mountain, found long ago by the adventurous O'Reilly family who imagined that anything could have remained hidden on this magical step between mountain and sky.



Overlooked by the dramatic Razorback Mountain and Lamington Plateau, the Lost World occupies enchanted valleys populated by tangled forests, verdant meadows, wild rivers, mesmerising rock pools and rare wildlife. A true rugged wilderness, this Scenic Rim gem offers the chance to disconnect from modern life and engage with nature.

Slow the pace along the scenic Lost World Tourist Drive through the Kerry

Valley, Lost World, Lamington Gorge and Christmas Creek, and get into farm-based activities at Tommerup's Dairy – open by appointment, on regular open days or as part of the Farm Gate Trails – where you can meet the menagerie of animals and stock up on farm-fresh produce.

Camp or stay in Lost World accommodation from charming cabins to historic homesteads. Gain access to private trails and pristine

swimming holes and try your hand at skills such as stockwhip-cracking and boomerang throwing. Christmas Creek, on the tip of Lamington National Park, also offers an enchanting immersive experience in nature, glamping in luxe safari tents at Nightfall Camp.
